

Plain Language Summary – Financial Assistance Policy

The Financial Assistance Policy at St. Veronica Senior Behavioral Health Hospital at Catholic Care Center (SVSBH) exists to provide eligible patients discounted medically necessary services. This summary provides a brief overview of SVSBH's Financial Assistance Policy. Patients seeking Financial Assistance must apply for the program.

Eligible Services

Medically necessary services provided by Catholic Care Center medical professionals.

Eligible Patients

Patients receiving eligible services who complete a Financial Evaluation form may be eligible for Financial Assistance. Patients with income that is less than 200% of the poverty level may be eligible for discounted rates on a sliding scale as detailed in the "Financial Assistance Rate Schedule" of the Financial Assistance Policy.

How to Apply

Patients may apply for Financial Assistance in person at Admissions or by meeting with the Catholic Care Center Business Office Manager. Applications for Financial Assistance may also be obtained online at Catholic Care Center's website. A Financial Assistance packet can also be requested via phone by calling St. Veronica Senior Behavioral Health Hospital at 316-744-4103.
